

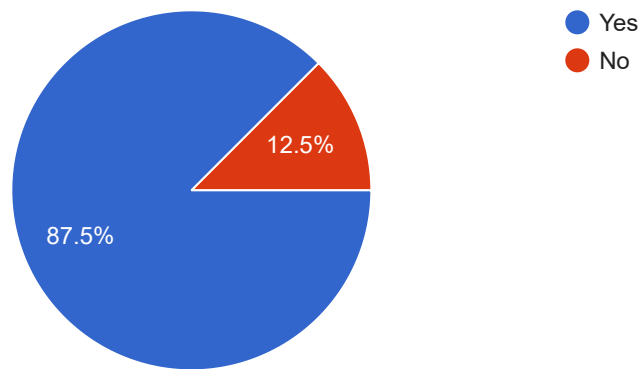

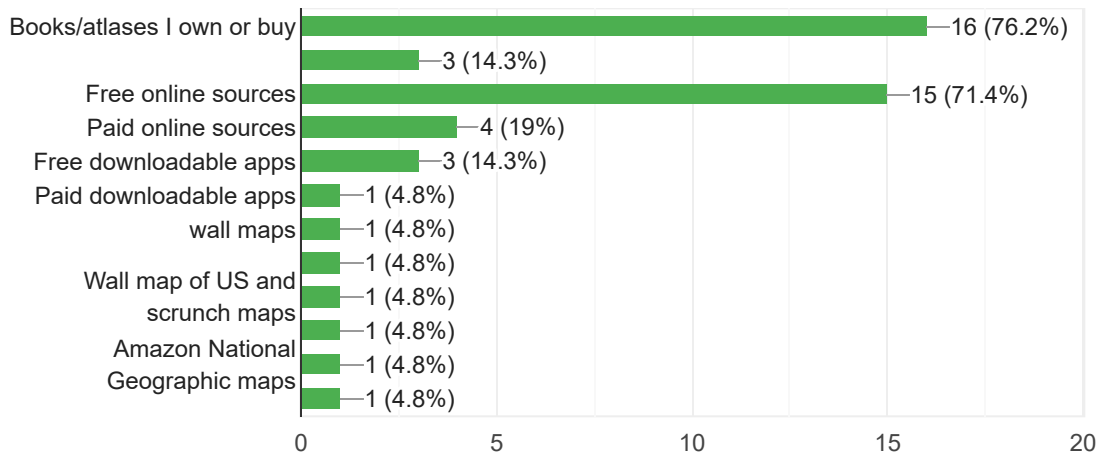

Where do you get the maps used for your homeschool instruction? (Check all that apply)

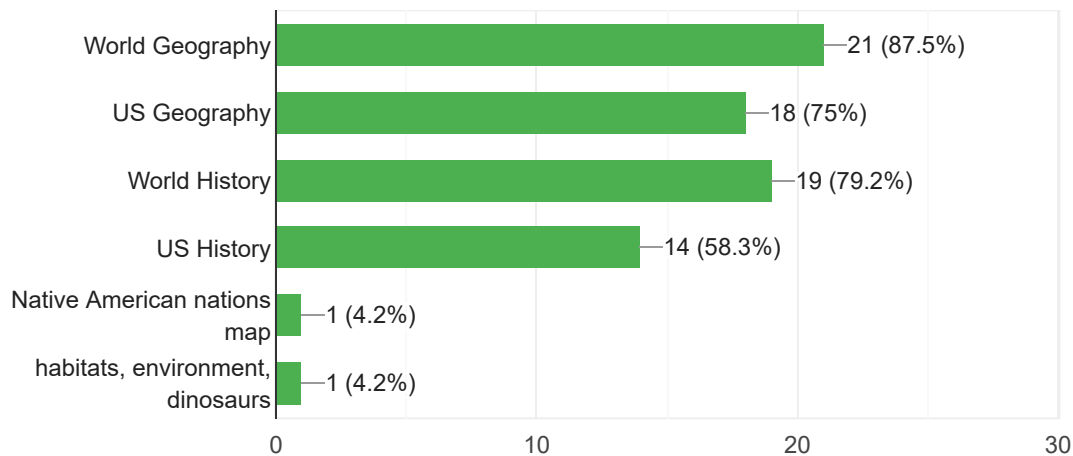

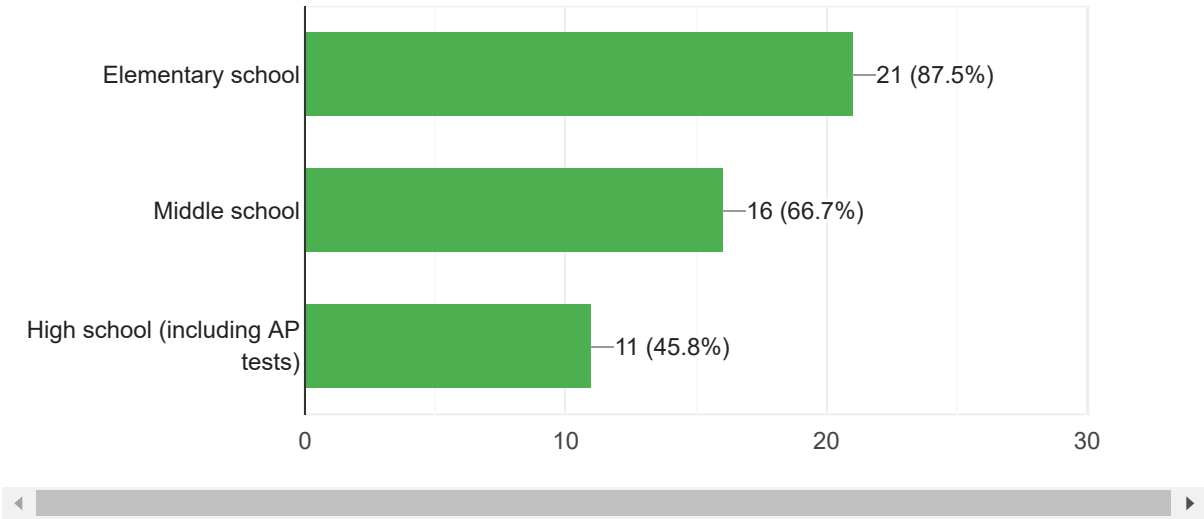
If you were to purchase a map-based curriculum aide(s), what major subject matter(s) would you want it/them to cover? (Check all that apply)

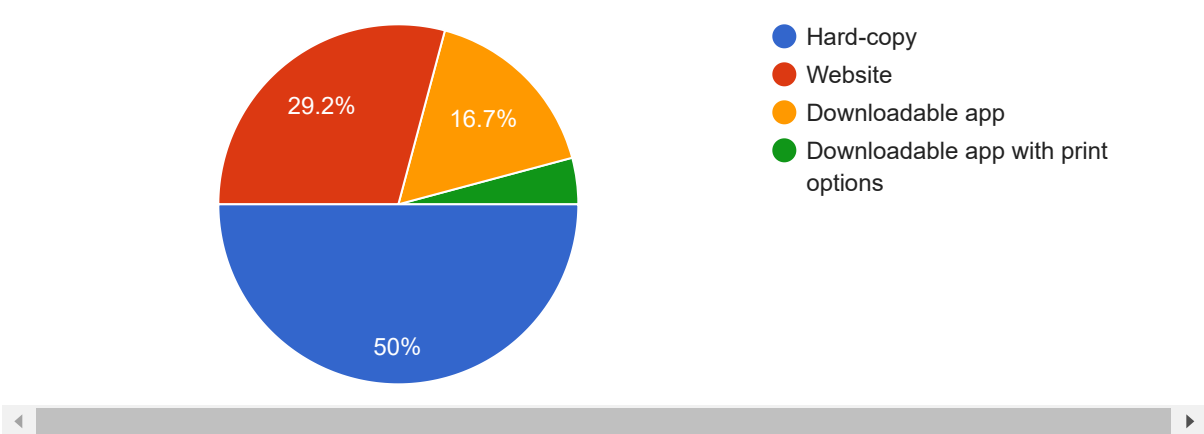

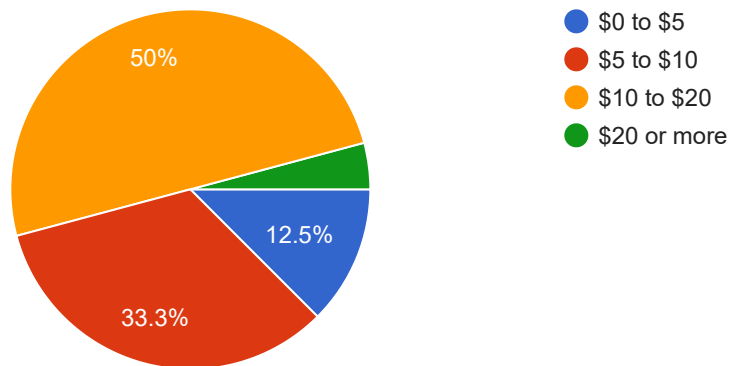

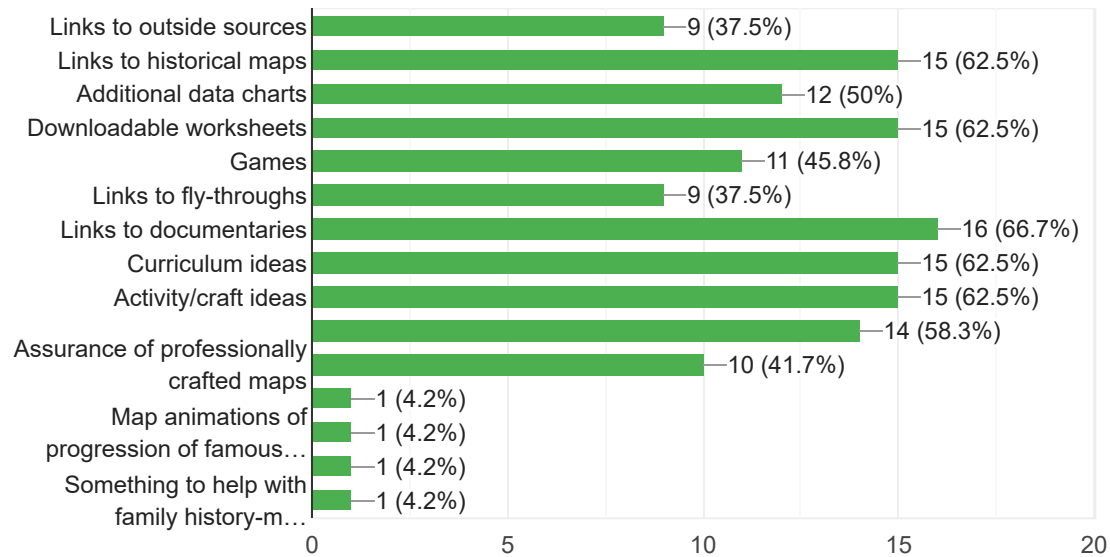
